- **C.** Brian Bowman said spring sports are concluding. He congratulated the students who qualified for the state track meet and state tennis meet.
- **D.** Brian Bowman congratulated the 2018 seniors who are graduating this year.

### IV. Superintendent's Report

- A. Board Recognitions Iowa School Board Recognition Month honors Iowa's volunteer school board members and recognizes that they are providing leadership through responsibilities ranging from strong financial stewardship to ensuring a rich and diverse curriculum. Saydel Board Members received tokens of appreciation from Cornell Elementary, Woodside Middle School, and Saydel High School students.
- B. Retirement Recognitions Superintendent Dr. Douglas Wheeler recognized three retirees and presented each of them with a plaque. Honored were ELP Teacher Carolyn McCauley (1994-2018), 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Social Studies Teacher Douglas Cline (2000-2018), and Family & Consumer Science Teacher Terry Lyons-Brix (2000-2018).

- V. Administrative Report to the Board TAP Program Update Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment Mary Salazar shared a program update for TAP. She reviewed the TAP

Best Practice Program Elements, which are: instructionally focused accountability, multiple career paths, and ongoing applied professional growth. Mary overviewed the themes of Equity and Collective Efficacy, which were the focus of the TAP National Conference held in Washington, D.C., in March. Saydel staff members joined in several days of learning to make sure that all students continue to learn and achieve at high levels. Mary then shared feedback from Saydel's NIET final formal school review. NIET Project Director Michael Derrick performed observations and interviews at all three schools and provided data, which was used to determine building glows and grows. Mary shared district action steps that will shape future work during Saydel's cluster cycles in the next school year.

- F. Negotiated Agreement Between the Saydel Education Association and the Saydel District for 2018-19 Motion to approve by Jennifer Van Houten, seconded by Chad Vitiritto. Motion carried 7/0. The Board was presented with the agreement reached between Saydel CSD and the Saydel Education Association (SEA) for 2018-19. The agreement has been ratified by the SEA. Approval of this agreement will establish a contract between the Saydel District and the SEA for three years. The settlement includes a 1.7% increase to base wages for the 2018-19 school year and a 1.6% increase to base wages for the 2019-20 school year. The Board approved changes to the master contract for the 2018-19 school year.
