STATEMENT OF GUIDING PRINCIPLES

It is the policy of the Board of Directors to organize and maintain the distinction between those activities which are appropriate to the Board of Directors as the legislative governing body of the School District, and those administrative activities which are to be performed by the Superintendent of Schools and his/her staff in the exercise of a delegated administrative authority. The functions of the Board can be described as policy-making and evaluation.

The Board of Directors will have the further duty of providing the financial means by which the educational program is conducted. They will also ensure that the community be informed of the needs, purposes, values and status of the schools.
