

STUDENT SCHOOL BOARD REPRESENTATIVES

Student school board representative(s) eligibility and duties:

The student school board representative(s) shall be a full-time high school student in the district;

The student school board representative(s) shall participate in an orientation of board responsibilities and procedures as determined by the Superintendent;

The student school board representative(s) shall be eligible to participate in discussion, but not vote, at all regular board meetings held in open session;

The student school board representative(s) shall be responsible for communicating board decisions and information to the student body; and

The student school board representative(s) will be provided with and shall abide by all applicable sections of the Board Members Code of Ethics.

The term of office shall be from the first regular board meeting in September to the last regular board meeting in May.

If the student school board representative is unable to attend a board meeting, the student school board representative must notify the Superintendent of the absence. A student school board representative who neglects his/her duties may be removed from the position at the discretion of the Board.
