QUORUM

Action by the Board regarding the affairs of the school district may be taken only when a quorum, a majority of the Board members, is in attendance at the board meeting.

While Board members are expected to attend all board meetings, four (4) Board members will constitute a quorum and are a sufficient number to transact business of the school corporation. The adjournment of a meeting may be executed without a quorum.

An affirmative vote of a majority of the votes cast will be sufficient to pass a motion or take action unless law or board policy requires a vote of a greater number.
