FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Foreign students must meet all district entrance requirements including age, place of residence and immunization. Foreign students must be approved by the board of education.

The board reserves the right to limit the number of foreign exchange students accepted to no more than two per school year. The organization sponsoring the foreign exchange student must contact the district administration by no later than June 1 preceding the requested year of participation.

Students who are citizens of a foreign country will be considered residents if they meet one of the following requirements:

- The student resides with his/her parent(s) or legal guardian;
- The student is in the United States with appropriate documentation (Form I-20) from the United States Department of Justice-Immigration and Naturalization Services: or
- The student is a participant in a recognized foreign exchange program.

Each foreign exchange student must be physically able to attend school and have provided the school district with such proof, including a current TB test.
