NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

Students who are eligible to attend an lowa public school but who are not legal residents of the school district may be admitted into the school district at the discretion of the Superintendent upon application and payment of tuition. The tuition rate will be the current per-pupil cost of the school district as computed by the Business Manager and as authorized by the lowa Department of Education.

Resident students whose families move from the school district after the start of a semester and who wish to complete the semester in the school district may be permitted to attend without the payment of tuition at the discretion of the Superintendent and approval of the Board. Students who plan to open enroll to the non-resident district may complete the school year without approval of the Superintendent or Board.

Students in grades eleven or twelve who are no longer residents of the school district, but were residents in the preceding school year, may continue to attend school until they graduate without the payment of tuition.

Non-resident students who are eligible to attend an lowa public school and who have evidence they will become legal residents of the school district on or before October 1 of that school year may be allowed to attend without the payment of tuition.
