PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS

Ease of administration will be the primary consideration for payroll deductions, other than those required by law. Payroll deductions will be made for federal income tax withholdings, lowa income tax withholdings, social security, and the lowa Public Employees' Retirement System.

Employees may elect to have payments withheld for professional dues, district-related and mutually agreed upon group insurance coverage, and/or tax sheltered annuity programs. Requests for these deductions will be made in writing to the Business Manager. Request for purchase or change of tax-sheltered annuities may be made in writing and by filling out the necessary form with the Business Manager.

It will be the responsibility of the Superintendent to determine which additional payroll deductions will be allowed.

Certified collective bargaining unit and the Board regarding payroll deductions of such employees will be followed.
