I. Welcome and Introductions

Melissa Crosse welcomed attendees to the Community Education meeting.

II. Review of Fall Activities

Melissa Crosse reviewed the fall activities offered by Community Education.

Power School 101 was offered to parents and guardians who have students in grades 5-12 within the school district. There was no cost for the course offered on September 27, 2017, and there was one parent in attendance.

The Little Eagle Cheer Clinic was offered on September 21 with the performance on Friday, September 22 at the high school football game. Ninety-five girls in grades K-6th attended the clinic and performance. The Saydel Cheer Team made \$782.18 after t-shirts and snacks fees were subtracted and paid from the total funds collected.

III. Preview of Winter Activities

Melissa Crosse discussed the winter activities beginning over the next couple weeks. She also discussed having other events scheduled after the December school break.

A. Community Classes

Adult Boot Camp is a boot camp fitness class hosted by PhysioTherapy Associates with instructor Maka Stewart. It offers various levels of cardiovascular endurance and muscular endurance, muscular strength for any adult condition. The class begins November 2 and will be held on November 7, 9, 15, 16 and 21^{st} from 5:30 AM - 6:30 AM in the Saydel High School North Gym. There is a one-time fee of \$25 for the month of November.

B. Youth Athletic Opportunities

1. Boys Youth Basketball Camp

Saydel students in grades 3-8 can participate in the Boys Youth Basketball Camp instructed by Brian Baker and the Varsity Basketball Coaching Staff. The camp will focus on the fundamentals, teamwork and sportsmanship. Camp fee is \$25 and will be held October 30, 31, November 1 & 2 at the Saydel High School South Gym for the following grades and times: 3rd-4th Grade, 5:30-6:30 PM

5th-6th Grade, 6:30-7:30 PM 7th-8th Grade, 4:30-5:30 PM

2. 80/35 Youth Basketball League

Saydel community boys and girls in grades 3rd-6th can register to play January 6, 13, 20, 27 and February 3 hosted by the 80/35 League Association. Players are assigned a team by grade level. Practices will begin in early November. There will be games played at home and away at locations and parent volunteer coaches are needed. A fee of \$60 per student includes the rental jersey, scheduling fee and officials.

IV. Prioritize Next Steps

An art class, music lessons are a couple being worked out. Others that may be of interest include a youth dance and cheer camp and adult pilates, yoga, and gardening classes. Another interest is doing a parent and child course such as an art, cooking or another type of parent and child class. Some members of the committee feel there may be interest in offering an adult fitness class in the evening.
