Saydel Girls Basketball

The Saydel girls took on Roland Story on Tuesday, and came away with a 58-48 win. Both teams started slowly, but Saydel took a 13-10 lead after one quarter. The Eagles started to extend their lead in the second period, only to see Roland Story finish on a 7-2 run, but Saydel still took a 26-23 lead into the half. The Eagles came out after half and extended the lead to 14 points, thanks to some good defense which led to some easy baskets. The Eagles extended their lead to 18, but Roland Story got hot from three point land to cut the lead back to 9 with a minute to go, however the Eagles finished them off from the free throw line. The Eagles had a balanced attack led by Cassie Chubb with 14 points, Brooklyn Allgood and Gabbie Richards each scored 13, Jordan Johnson had 8, Katelyn McEachron had 6, Lesa Wicks 2, and Liz Miklus and April Knight had 1. This win makes the Eagles 2-0 on the season, and 2-0 in the conference.

Eagles vs. Polar Bears

On Thursday, the Eagles traveled up 2nd Avenue to play the North Polar Bears. Even though North has struggled for wins over the past few years, sometimes playing with intensity and focus is hard to do against these types of teams.
