The Eagles new they had to get the bats going early if they were going to pull off the victory. Senior Mackenzie Miller playing in her final game on the home field for the Eagles took care of the scoring by blasting a huge grand slam in the bottom of the second inning. That was her third big fly of the year and put her in a tie for the team lead in homeruns. The mammoth shot put the Cardinals in a huge hole and the Eagle defense slammed the door shut behind the solid pitching of Annika Hofbauer. Hofbauer picked up her 10th win on the season and lowered

her team leading 3.22 ERA. The Eagles were all over the base paths all night en route to the 6-0 victory with contributions coming from Liz Miklus. The junior center fielder has had a great 2014 season as she hit .568 with 33 runs scored and 25 stolen bases. She is one triple shy of beating her own school season record of 4 triples in a year. 

The win was the 20th on the season for Saydel The Eagles honored the career accomplishments of seven seniors in front of great crowd. Senior Alex Gustafson and sophomore Dylan Coffin each added 3 hits for the Eagles and Senior Brandon Hodges continued his strong pitching

with a six inning, seven strikeout performance. Brandon was selected as the Iowa Sports Spotlight/ Hyvee Horizon Student Athlete of the Week. Brandon will be presented his award and honored at the next home game, Tuesday night against Bondurant.
