Girl's Basketball wins a pair

The Saydel Girls played last Friday against CMB. The Eagles started off slow and looked pretty rusty after the long Christmas Break and find themselves down 10-7 after one period. The Eagles started to show some life, and pulled ahead 26-21 at the half. After the half it was all Eagles, as they held CMB to 3 points in the 3rd period to pull away to 54-36 win.

Saydel was led in scoring by Cassie Chubb with 15 points, Jordan Johnson followed with 12, Brooklyn Allgood had 9, Liz Miklus had 5, Gabbie Richards and Lesa Wicks each scored 4, Katelyn McEachron had 3, and Emma Bowman 2.

This win pushes the teams record to 8-2 overall.

On Tuesday, Saydel traveled to South Hamilton. The Eagles came out much faster than there previous game and held a 33-17 advantage. The Eagles again came out in the 3rd quarter strong on defense, and held South Hamilton to a single point and held a 53-18 lead. The last quarter went fast, and saw lots of people play, as the Eagles won 64-26.

The Eagles were led in scoring by Brooklyn Allgood with 15 points, Liz Miklus and Jordan Johnson each scored 10 points, Emma Bowman had 8, Katelyn McEachron 6, Gabbie Richards and Cassie Chubb each with 5, Lesa Wicks and Jayda Tolentino had 2, and Katie Schmidt had 1.

The win helps the Eagles to improve to 9-2 overall for the season, with a big game at Roland Story on Friday the 16th.

Cross Country Rule Change for 2015

(Des Moines Register) Iowa girls' cross country runners will race the same distance as boys starting this fall. The Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union's board of directors voted to extend the distance of races from 4,000 to 5,000 meters.

Iowans have competed at 4K (about 2.5 miles) since 2002. The new distance covers 3.1 miles. "It will be a positive thing for the sport," said Johnston girls' coach Pat Hennes, who led his school to the Class 4-A state championship last fall. "There's no doubt in my mind that our athletes are ready for that."




PITCHING
