8th Grade: Parents, just a reminder that State Law requires all students transitioning into 9th grade to have a professional dental screening. This must be done by a dentist or a dental hygienist. The forms should be at the dentist office and are due the first week of school Call with any questions!

7th Grade: As your student enters 7th grade next fall, I want to remind you that Iowa Immunization law changed 2 years ago to now require that all students entering 7th grade have the Tdap booster. This is due the first week of school and I will need proof from the doctor that this was given. They will be given a grace period if you have an appointment scheduled and after that the student will be unable to attend school.

They can receive this at their regular physician or at Polk County Health Department. There are numerous free clinics that are available to do sports physicals as well as immunizations. This list is available in the school office. There are English and Spanish available. If you have any questions, please speak with me.
